## Contract for Sale and Purchase of a Dog

(In this contract reference to a "dog" includes a bitch)

(NOTE Dogs New Zealand registration formalities must be completed upon the "sale, exchange, gift, transfer or other disposition" of the dog. Unless this document or the law specifically states otherwise this date is the date of delivery or possession of the dog.)

## General Undertakings - Applicable In All Cases.

- 1. The vendor(s) undertakes that the dog is their unconditional property and (if applicable) is registered in their name with Dogs New Zealand (DNZ).
- 2. The vendor(s) undertakes to complete all DNZ registration and transfer formalities in accordance with this agreement. If the dog is not already registered with DNZ the vendor undertakes to complete the registration and transfer of the dog to the purchaser(s) within 14 days of the date of possession.
- **3.** The purchaser(s) undertakes to make all payments due under this agreement on due date.
- 4. The parties to this agreement acknowledge that this is a civil contract and all laws pertaining to civil contracts apply including, but not limited to, the Consumer Guarantees Act, the Fair Trading Act and contract law. Any breach of this contract may give rise to civil remedies. DNZ does not have jurisdiction to impose penalties for any breach of this contract.
- **5.** The vendor(s) confirms that the dog has undertaken the vaccination programme indicated in the annexed veterinary certificate. *Annex Certificate (If Nil State)* ......
- 6. The purchaser(s) undertakes to present the dog to a veterinary surgeon of their choice within two days of the date of purchase. The purchaser(s) can return the dog for any reason arising from the inspection and a full refund of the purchase price and all reasonable costs incurred by the purchaser(s) will be made. The vendor(s) will only be liable for any defect or illness arising during the period of time that the dog was under the vendor(s) care with the exception of any illness or defect that would not have been apparent at such inspection. If the purchaser(s) are in default of this clause the vendors will not be liable for any defect or illness whatsoever.
- 7. It is the responsibility of the purchaser(s) to undertake any registration with a local authority required under the Dog Control Act. This registration is in addition to any registration with DNZ.
