Any club registered as an Obedience society may compete for the trophy.

Teams

A team shall comprise of three handlers and dogs competing in three different tests.

Teams must be in prior to Saturday judging commencing.

No dog or handler may compete in more than one team.

Every dog and handler entered must compete in every exercise in each test for which it is nominated for the team.

If a dog is withdrawn from any part of the test the whole team is disqualified.

Scoring

Points will be allocated to each handler according to their placings in the nominated test— ie. 1st = 1 point, 2nd = 2 points and so on. The points gained by each of the three handlers are added to form a team total.

The winning team is the team with the lowest total points.

In the event of a tie, the team with the highest overall percentage of total points in each test will be declared the winner.
